Homeless Hosting Appeal

Upbeat Communities runs 3 hosting schemes to offer emergency accommodation: Host Derby, Host Nottingham, and a new Refugee Lodgings scheme that enables new refugees to pay rent to a live-in landlord through Universal Credit. However, we don't have any hosts for Refugee Lodgings yet and we have limited hosts for Host Derby and Host Nottingham. This means we are having to turn people away on a weekly basis. We've launched a campaign to urgently recruit more hosts, and we hope you'll help us in spreading the word. Maybe you could even consider hosting yourself. We are running two information sessions in June. They will be online and will last for an hour. There's no commitment—it's just a chance for people to find out more: Information attached.
